What does it take to become a Student Ambassador?

- Strong academic, interpersonal, and organizational skills.
- Desire to share your Central Virginia Community College experience with others.
- A 2.5 GPA, with a minimum of six credit hours completed at CVCC by the end of summer 2021.
- Availability to serve as a Student Ambassador during the following semesters: fall 2021 (training), spring 2022 and summer 2022.

Student Ambassador Expectations (Required):

- Provide tours of campus to visiting groups.
- Obtain a background check through our Human Resources Department.
- Attend a Student Ambassador training.
- Assist with information sessions on campus and virtually.
- Attend the virtual VCCS Student Leadership Conference November 12
- Maintain at least a 2.5 GPA each semester: through Summer 2022.
- Maintain enrollment of at least six credits during fall 2021 and spring 2022.
- Complete 30 hours of campus service during spring 2022.

Student Ambassador Program Benefits:

- Develop leadership skills and build your resume.
- Serve the CVCC campus community.
- Get to know other student leaders, as well as key faculty and staff.
- Obtain a \$500 scholarship: \$500 for spring 2022.
