1. Discuss the opportunity with your parent/guardian. They should be onboard with this.
2. Schedule an appointment with your school counselor.
3. Discuss the programs available that may provide the skills in your area of interest.
4. Fill out the Google Form link [here](#).
5. Apply to Central Virginia Community College and get your CVCC ID number. For your convenience, [a link to the CVCC Application is available HERE](#)
6. After completing the Online application, look for your admission letter sent via email.
7. Within 24 hours, activate your myCVCC account using your temporary password (after 24 hours, your password will have to be reset)
8. Take the **CVCC Placement test in MATH and ENGLISH** and include the results in your application packet. Please note you MUST apply to CVCC before taking the test. Your school counselor or CVCC Career Coach will have information about specific dates and times. **(No Math or English testing for 2021-2022 applications)**
9. Applications are due
